

# RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All members must register at registration center after setting up on site. This is very important for you and us.
2. Quiet time is from 11 PM to 8 AM.
3. Speed limit throughout the park is 5 mph. This is for everyone's safety.
4. All children under 18 must be back to their campsite / rental units by 10 PM unless accompanied by parent.
5. All children must be accompanied at all times by an adult around pool and pond areas.
6. NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK - PLEASE BE CAREFUL!
7. Children under 8 must be supervised on the putt-putt course, shuffleboard, volleyball and basketball court, horseshoe pit, game room, etc.
8. No roller blading, skateboarding, riding bikes of any kind on the bathhouse ramps, pavilion ramps or under pavilion or sidewalks. All of the above must be at campsite / rental units by dark.
9. No glass containers allowed in pool areas.
10. All children that are not toilet trained must wear swimmyies in pool. (No diapers)
11. Campfires restricted to fire rings only.
12. No trees are to be cut for firewood. Chainsaws are not to be used in the resorts. You may bring firewood or purchase it at the store.
13. All tongues of travel trailer, fifth wheels, pop-ups and fronts of motor homes must face roadways.
14. Gray and sewer water must be disposed of by staff, blue tote or dumping at designated sanitation stations.
15. No ORV's are allowed in park unless authorized by management for disabilities.
16. No washing of any vehicle when camping or visiting the resort.
17. Please do not hang clotheslines in the resorts. We have washers and dryers for your convenience.
18. Any 4 to 14 night stay at any home park will require members to leave for a 7 day period. Then you may return.
19. RV's must be occupied the first night brought in and are not to be left unattended thereafter for more than one 24 hour period during the duration of your stay
20. Anyone wishing to place a vehicle in storage must sign a storage contract, available at registration centers.
21. Reservations are required and are accepted up to 3 months in advance for members and up to 1 month for guests. No reserving of specific sites. Member may have up to 3 reservations at any given time.
22. Members are responsible for the actions and conduct of their children and guests while visiting the resort. Any destruction of Outdoor Adventures property could result in a temporary suspension of your membership.
23. Trash pick up time is 11:00 a.m. daily. Trash must be bagged, tied and placed by road or disposed of in dumpster.
24. Outdoor Adventures reserves the right to move you from one site to another during your stay.
25. There is a \$25.00 campsite no show fee for anyone failing to cancel a campsite reservation 24 hours prior to arrival date. Rental accommodations must be canceled at least 14 days prior to arrival to avoid penalty. If you cancel less than 3 to 13 days in advance, you will lose one nights rental rate of your deposit. If you cancel less than 2 nights, do not call or do not show, you will be charged two nights rental rate.

## PET POLICIES

Owners must clean up after their pets. Pets must be on a leash at all times. Pets are not allowed in restrooms, pool, pavilion or beach areas. Do not leave pets unattended. Excessive barking of dogs may result in a request to remove dog from the facility. You must have proof of rabies vaccinations upon arrival to the resort.

**Excluded Dogs:** Akita, Alaskan Malamute, American Stafford Terrier, Bullmastiffs, Chow Chow, Doberman Pincher, Great Dane, Pit Bull, Presa Canario, Rottweiler, Siberian Husky, Staffordshire Bull Terrier, Wolf Hybrid and any dog that is a mixture of these breeds are not allowed.

**\*\*Excluded Dogs will be allowed providing owner carries a \$300,000.00 liability insurance policy. Any dogs that are vicious or with a history of biting will not be allowed.**
